



## Guide for construction of wrecked Japanese Zero.

1. Position cockpit and instrument panel into fuselage from underside.



2. Attach wing to fuselage.



3. Shape photo etched flaps by bending leading edge and end-cap 90 degrees. \*



4. Ribs can be twisted into position using tweezers.



5. Cockpit window frames can be shaped using supplied template.



6. Additional spars and ribs can be created using plastic strip.
